

# The Ultimate Wedding Planning Checklist

Getting married is an exciting, wonderful time! However, without effective planning and coordination, it can be a stressful, overwhelming exercise.

This Ultimate Wedding Planning Checklist will make the planning process smoother. This outlines the key steps and likely timings to make sure you enjoy your special day and create a celebration that you look back on with a smile on your face.

Nowadays, venues, photographers and Celebrants can be booked out years in advance. Consequently, booking these suppliers early is extremely wise.

## Your Checklist

## Once your Engaged

- Announce your engagement to friends and family
- Consider the role social media will play in your wedding journey
- Set up a wedding website can be a great way of communicating with friends and suppliers (<a href="https://www.easyweddings.com.au/planning-tools/website/">https://www.easyweddings.com.au/planning-tools/website/</a> provides a free service)
- Host an engagement party
- Have an engagement photo shoot (this is a good way to find out in advance if you've chosen the right photographer for your wedding)
- Start thinking about your vision and map out a wedding budget (be realistic and avoid overstretching)
- Pick your Maid of Honour, Best Man, Bridesmaids and Groomsmen
- Start researching possible reception venues, ceremony locations and celebrants
- Peruse different honeymoon locations, seasons and availability
- Look into possible gift registries
- Draft your guest list



#### Once the Wedding Date is Set

- Sook your reception venue and ceremony location
- Sook your Celebrant
- Complete your Notice of Intended Marriage with your Celebrant (this can be completed 18 months prior to your wedding date)
- Discuss your wedding ceremony schedule with your Celebrant. Your Celebrant will have lots of ideas
- Hire a wedding planner (if necessary and budget permits)
- Sook your photographer/ videographer
- Decide on your wedding theme
- Sesearch your wedding rings
- Start searching for your dream wedding dress and groom's suit
- Research your suppliers stylist, florist, cake, hair stylist, wedding cars, entertainment etc.
- Decide on a honeymoon destination and meet with a travel agent
- Order your passport if you plan to travel for your honeymoon (If you have a Passport check the expiry date. As a general rule, passports should have at least six months of validity when traveling internationally. Most countries will not permit a traveller to enter their country unless the passport is set to expire at least six months after the final day of travel)



## 6-9 Months Before Your Wedding

- Finalise your guest list
- Decide on your stationery and send out a save the date
- Order your invitations and thank you cards
- Plan any pre-wedding events ie Hens Night, Bucks Night, Pre-Wedding Dinner
- Sook any transportation needs and reserve hotel rooms for out-of-town guests
- Solution Revisit your budget to make sure you're on track and make any adjustments
- Confirm rentals you require, eg marquee, tables, chairs, linen and table settings





#### 3 - 6 Months Before Your Wedding

- Send out your official wedding invitations
- Confirm your suppliers: stylist, florist, cake, hair stylist, wedding cars, entertainment etc.
- Order wedding rings
- Onfirm wedding dress, bridesmaid's dress, groom's and groomsmen suits
- Formalise gift registry
- Sook honeymoon flights and accommodation
- Sook a hotel room for your wedding night

## 2 Months Before Your Wedding

- Consider if you wish to write your vows and choose any ceremony readings/music
- Discuss with your Celebrant if there is need for a Ceremony rehearsal
- Choose your first dance song
- Pick up wedding rings and ensure sizing is correct
- Conduct any pre-wedding events ie Hens Night, Bucks Night
- Consider and purchase thank you gifts for the bridal party
- Organise a pre-wedding photo-shoot
- Organise a trial for both hair and make-up



#### 3 - 6 Weeks Before Your Wedding

- Have a final fitting for the entire bridal party
- Monitor RSVP's and follow up with friends and family who haven't RSVP'd yet
- Confirm final numbers with the wedding reception
- Re-confirm honeymoon details with travel agent

## 1 - 3 Weeks Before Your Wedding

- Meet with your Celebrant to finalise Ceremony details/Conduct Rehearsal
- Complete the No Impediment for Marriage document with your Celebrant
- Confirm any last-minute details with your stylist and venue
- Pick up wedding dress, bridesmaids dresses and groomsmen suits
- Clean engagement ring
- Write speeches
- Reconfirm timings for all booked suppliers
- Send detailed instructions to your bridal party and vendors, including the final schedule for the ceremony and reception
- Prepare payment for all your vendors
- Pack for your honeymoon
- Selax and enjoy the countdown

#### The week before

- Solution Build a bridal emergency kit with tissues, lipstick, band aids, a sewing kit, safety pins etc.
- Check the weather forecast and make any required alternative plans
- Pack all your wedding day items including your rings, booking receipts, passports, shoes, accessories
- Arrange for someone in your wedding party to transport any gifts or flower arrangements before and after the wedding
- Arrange for someone to collect the Ceremonial Marriage Certificate from your Celebrant at the conclusion of the Ceremony
- Arrange for return of rental items
- Set as much rest as possible





## Your Wedding Day

- S Enjoy the day
- Give the rings to the best man/maid of honour
- Spend a lot of time getting ready
- Seat breakfast
- Seep hydrated
- Attend hair and makeup appointments
- Include your photographer in the wedding preparation process
- Give your bridal party their gifts
- Meet with your vendors and officiant and go over any final arrangements
- Get dressed
- Get married!
